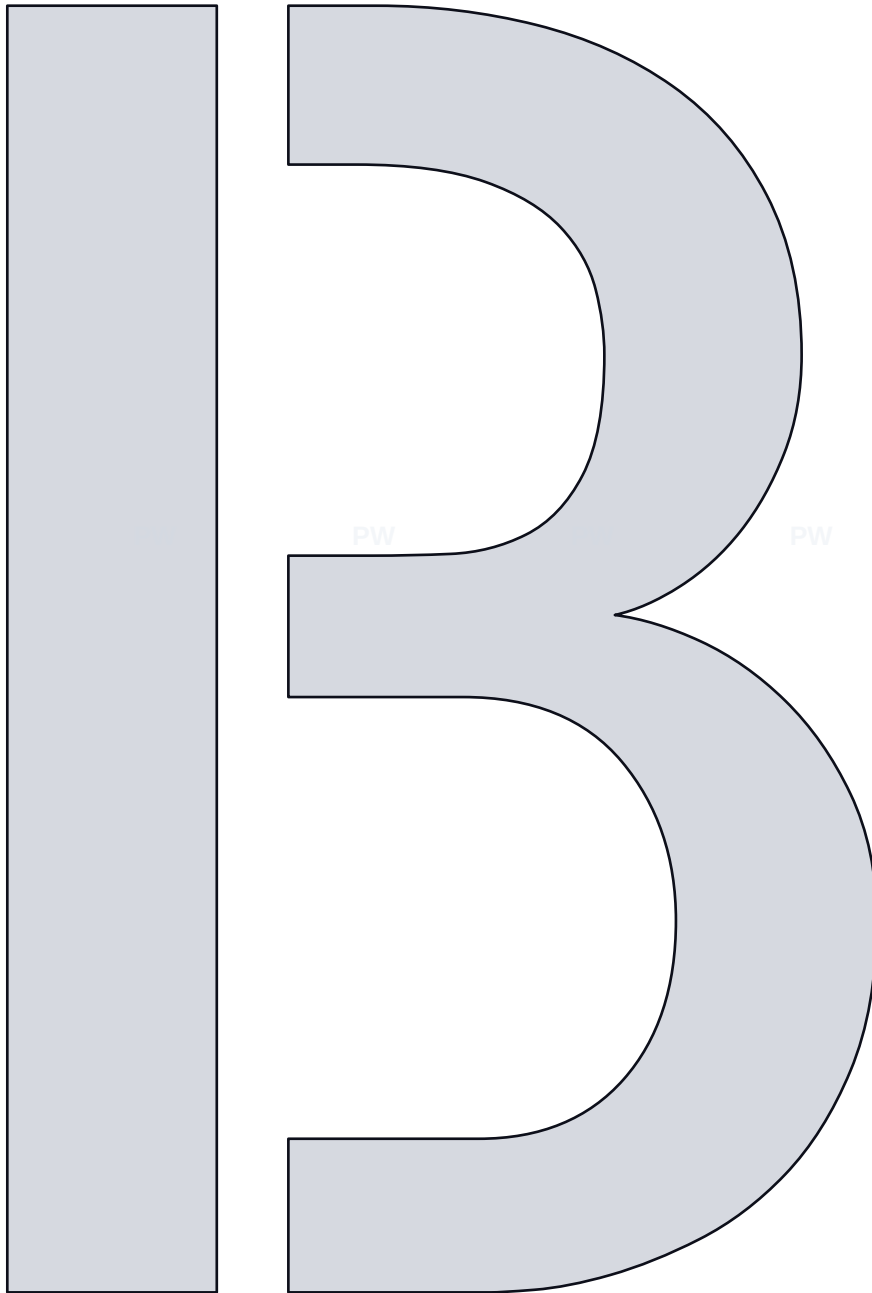


Pumpkin Carving Stencils

classroom-activities

Tape the sheet to the pumpkin. Poke holes along every black line about 5 mm apart with a pin or nail, then peel the paper off and carve dot to dot. Grey areas are the parts you cut out.

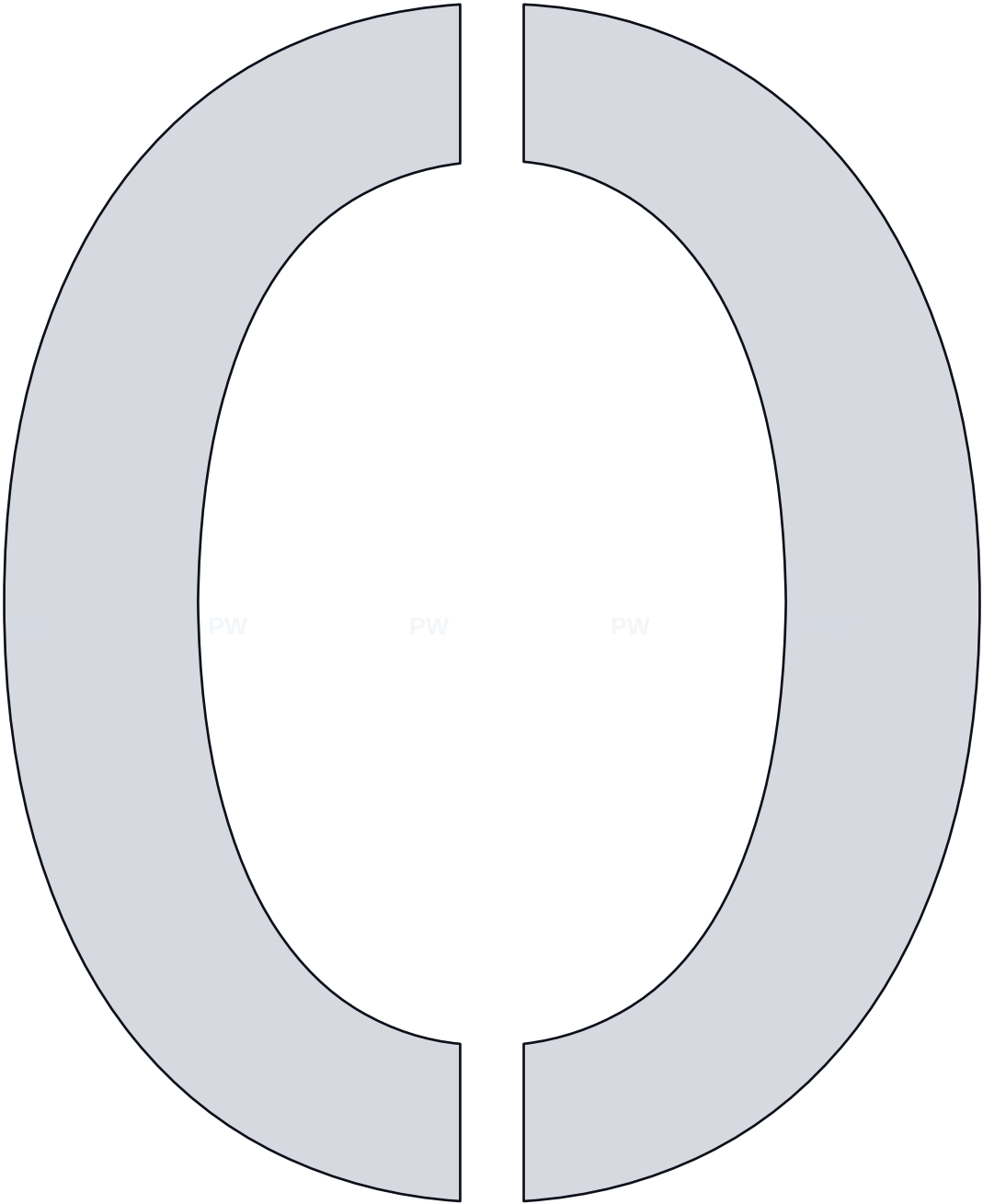
Keep the white bridges: they hold the middle of letters like B, O and 8 to the pumpkin. Cut the smallest pieces first and the biggest last so the shell stays firm.
